#### Did you know that laughing is good for your heart.

Studies have shown that your blood vessels relax when you're laughing, which sends 20% more blood through your body. Relaxed blood vessels mean your heart doesn't have to work as hard.

#### Did you know that a "broken heart" can feel like a heart attack.

Intense and sudden feelings of sadness can mimic the symptoms of a heart attack, also known as "broken heart syndrome." Stress hormones are released into the body and can cause chest pain and shortness of breath. Luckily, with a little bit of rest, your heart will begin to feel normal.

#### Did you know that a male's heart is bigger than a female's heart.

A female's heart is usually smaller in size, while a male's heart is larger.

#### Did you know that a female's average heartbeat is faster than a males.

By almost eight beats a minute women's heart beat faster. The reason? Females need their hearts to beat more to pump the same amount of blood because of its size.

The heart is an amazing thing. Wondered why does the heart symbolize love? Probably because of the pitter-patter you feel in your chest when Cupid's arrow strikes. But in truth, your brain controls love.

Scripture says, "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me."

-Psalm 51:10. Because our lives depend on it, let us seek a pure heart. Let's ask God to renew our hearts. The heart matters, and it needs to be routinely checked. A hypothetical stress test is done when we face opposing or challenging circumstances. These are opportunities to know the condition of our hearts, and then plan what to do about it.

Let us use our heart to love, to unite, to serve, to bless, and to Praise the Lord. More than provide heart with purpose, it also exercises it.

If our hearts are "two sizes too small" or like "a dead tomato splotched with moldy purple spots", let's open ourselves up to a different way of doing life. Perhaps, like Mr. Grinch our hearts may grow three sizes at the end! (I had to sneak in some Christmas in there.)

#### **AD COUNCIL MEETING—July 7, 2024**

Ad Council met on July 7th. Pastor reviewed the Wisconsin Annual Conference meeting. It was mentioned each church and pastor need to review their own wedding policy. We will review the policy each year. It was decided to put the baptismal font on the stairs landing with some water in it for people to remember their baptism. We donated 60 blankets to the Royal Kids Camp. Relay for Life raised \$12,511. We plan to do the Holiday Cookie fundraiser but need to review how to increase sales and have enough bakers. SPRC (Staff Parish Relations Committee) will meet on July 21st.

The Trustees fixed the toilet, replaced lights in the Fellowship Hall, added a dehumidifier to the classroom, and cleaned bathroom water filter. Our copier is getting old and we received two bids for leasing or purchasing a new copier and will discuss at the August meeting after more information. Our organist will be gone August 11 and 18. We will have a substitute pianist on August 18 with payment between \$50 to \$75. We discussed the speaker and monitor going on the back wall of the sanctuary. We made a motion to spend up to \$1,000 for a monitor with the money coming from parsonage sale account. The July Senior Fellowship was Laura Carnahan on Weather. Game Night will be on Friday, September 20. We approved the May and June treasurer's reports and filed for future audit. An idea was mentioned to have a Back to School Bash at the end of August with Bounce House, collect school supplies, balloon animals, and games. After discussion we will postpone the event until we have discussion with getting help from a group like the the high school to help. Our next meeting will be Sunday, August 4.

We ordered the boxes for Operation Christmas Child (OCC) We would like to review the Holiday Cookie Sales once we have the results from the previous sales. SPRC review the duties of the pastor and check with her as to how she is doing. We discussed the two bids for the copier. We made a motion to purchase the copier from James Imaging for \$4,500 with money coming from Parsonage sale and have an annual maintenance agreement. Trustees has sprayed bugs and put out mice bait. Someone cleaned out the window wells, since we had some leaking in the Fellowship Hall. We will replace the window well covers and maybe have someone look to see if we have foundation issue.

We will have Alex Hood play piano on August 18th for \$75. We will be doing Contemporary music on August 11 and get the PowerPoint online for \$15 per song from the Worship budget. The August Senior Fellowship will be Rachel Hewitt on Royal Family Kids. We approved the July treasurer's report and filed for future audit. The dates for the Textile Recycle will be September 7th at Pleasant Prairie UMC and September 14th at Bristol from 9 am to 12 pm. We need to replace the monitor for a larger one and speaker was hard to turn on since too high to reach. The motion from the July 7th meeting was modified to include the speaker and monitor up to \$1,000 and money from Parsonage sale. The secretary will be on vacation September 4th to 18th. Our next meeting will be Sunday, September 8th.

We want to thank **Rachel and Cameron Hewitt** for preparing the PowerPoint presentation and streaming the worship service every Sunday. .




