After worship we will be decorating the sanctuary for the Advent season. Hope you will join us.

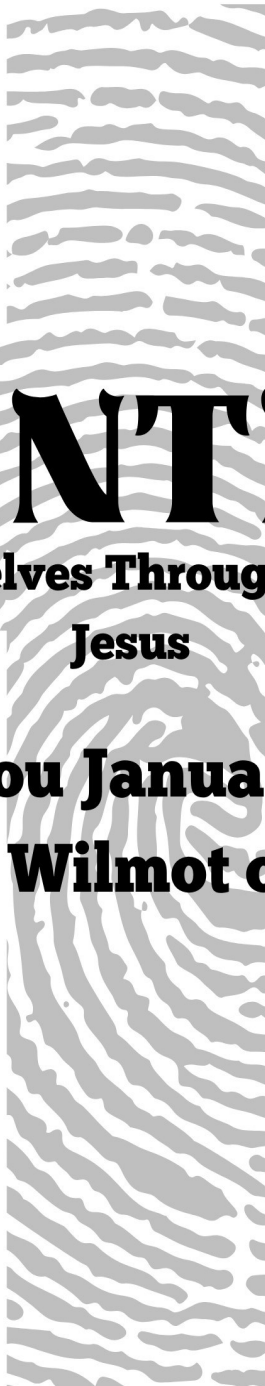

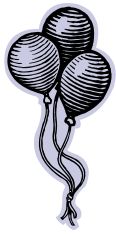
We would like to thank **Rachel Hewitt** for her testimony during the service on October 13th.
