# Membership Vs Discipleship



Have you been in church sitting in the same pews for many years? Have you ever felt that church should be more than going to church on Sundays for an hour or two? When was the last time that you felt the urge to talk to someone about Christ? Is your heart fired up to be a witness of Christ, and allow others to see that Jesus is alive through you, the Church?

Jesus told the disciples in Matthew 28:18-20 <sup>18</sup> *Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, <sup>[b]</sup> baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Teach these **NEW DISCIPLES** to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”*

Although Jesus told this to the disciples, the intention of Christ was for the new disciples to continue making more disciples. The Church should be a living organism of disciples making new disciples. The purpose of the church is to continue making disciples of Jesus Christ. If you feel that the Church should be more than Sunday services, you are right!

To be honest, the disciples did not do it by themselves. They needed the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. Jesus told the disciples in Act 1:8 <sup>8</sup> *“But you will receive **POWER** when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” (NLT)*

Later, we see how that word was made reality in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter:

*“On the day of Pentecost<sup>[a]</sup> all the believers were meeting together in one place. <sup>2</sup> Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. <sup>4</sup> And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages,<sup>[b]</sup> as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.”*

Right after that happen, Peter started to preach to all who were listening outside the upper room. Peter’s preaching was delivered with the **power** of the Holy Spirit that was poured out unto him and that day about 3,000 people believed. What does this means for us? Well, this means that we, as the church of Christ, need to be hungry & praying for the power or the Holy Spirit so after we receive that power, we can share the gospel to all the people around us, and make new disciples! Jesus doesn’t seek for a church full of members. He planned for a church full of disciples.

## AD COUNCIL MEETING

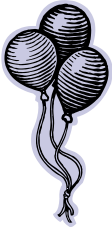
